


Early Literacy Log June 22 • June 22 •



Early Literacy is what children learn about reading and writing before they can actually read and write.

There are six Early Literacy skills your child can start learning from birth:

- 1. **Print motivation** being interested in and enjoying books.
- 2. **Phonological awareness** being able to hear the smaller sounds in words.
- 3. **Vocabulary** knowing the names of things.
- 4. **Narrative skills** being able to describe things and events and tell stories.
- 5. **Print awareness** noticing print, knowing how to handle a book and knowing how to follow words on a page.
- 6. **Letter knowledge** knowing letters are different from each other; knowing their names and sounds and recognizing letters everywhere.


